READINESS SKILLS: Getting-to-know-you activities, sharing and conflict resolution skills, and health and safety rules that make life at school pleasant for everyone will take center stage.

LANGUAGE SKILLS: We will take dictation as the children tell about themselves.

MOTOR SKILLS: Fine motor skills will concentrate on tearing, coloring, and gluing. Gross motor skills – jumping, climbing, and running will be practiced on the playground.

SCIENCE: The children will discover how apples grow from bud to blossom to fruit. We will be discussing the different ways you can use apples and identify the different colors of apples.

HEALTH/HYGIENE: Proper hand washing, sneezing and nose blowing techniques will be practiced.

BIBLE TIME: We will be going into the sanctuary to learn about the Bible through stories, songs and prayers. (If your child arrives after Bible Time has started, please bring them to the sanctuary and stay with them in the back pews until the end which is usually about 25 after the hour.)
