From the Pastor's Desk

Drive-thru Ashes Wednesday, February 17

If in person worship has resumed, we will hold Ash Wednesday worship with solemn Imposition of Ashes on Wednesday, February 17, 2021 beginning at 6:00pm. The service will also include scripture, music, prayer, and preaching all within our established social distanced and CoVid-19 safe protocol as was our practice over the summer.

If in person worship has not resumed, Imposition of Ashes will be offered in what has come to be called 'drive through' style beginning at 6:00pm and continuing until 7:00pm. In order to allow for safe traffic flow, please enter the church drive only if there is single file room for your car to fully exit clear of Lavinia Drive with none of your vehicle protruding into traffic. Otherwise circle around the block again until safe space opens up. Follow the line back to the rear of the parking lot where Pastor Mike will be. Roll down the window and lean your head toward him (or your hand if you prefer the ashes there). Passengers may also receive.

After imposition, exit the lot so that everyone who wishes can experience this service. Scripture, music, prayer and preaching can then be seen online beginning at 7:00pm.

The symbol of Ashes reminds us of our limited time on earth and of God's grace. Ash Wednesday is the initiation of the season of Lent. The Lenten season is a spiritual journey extending until Resurrection Sunday, Easter which will be on April 4 this year.

Lent is for us, a time of prayer (Matthew 6) self-reflection and deepened spiritual attention. Many will engage in acts of kindness and compassion. Some may also choose to devote specific time for scripture reading or an additional inspirational program.


