OUTREACH MINISTRY UPDATE COLLECTION THRU SEPTEMBER 11

St. Philip's has a long history of participation, with donations of many kinds. In the last two years, because of covid, we asked for cash contributions only.

- Adult toothbrushes (individually packaged or in two packs)

- Dental floss, any kind or size

For sanitary reasons, it is important the toothbrushes be in the original packages, please do not include large packages of toothbrushes.
